Dear Captain,

Good Day. The next employment for vessel Voy23 will be taking a cargo of barley from New York to Algeciras. We will have full instructions for you shortly.

Upon completion discharging salt at berth 7 in Brooklyn, NY for Voy22 and once harbor pilot is aboard, pls proceed to the berth 58 in Port Elizabeth, NJ to load barley.

Agreed quantity of bagged barley in the CP is for 10,000 tons. Average stowfactor of bagged barley is 62.7 cu.ft./ton.

Agents for the load will be Oldship Inc in New Jersey. Please contact them soonest to advise eta and commence pre-arrival formalities.
